Program Overview

Throughout the JustFaith journey, participants deepen their faith, broaden their perspectives, and forge connections to social ministry. Groups are comprised of 10-15 participants and are co-facilitated by two participants from the group, using materials provided upon registration.

Sessions

- Twenty-four 2-1/2 hour sessions, broken into four phases of six sessions
- A short, fifth phase for participants who want to discern next steps
- Sessions include prayer, dialogue, active listening, and relationship-building. Some sessions include videos and/or guest speakers.

Resources

Participants deepen their understanding through dialogue, reflection, reading books, and viewing DVDs and online material

Immersion

In each phase, participants visit local organizations to meet with people who are living and working on the margins of society
